In June, the SWITCH project continued its impactful work through the Upskilling Labs and vibrant intercultural dialogue sessions, empowering participants with essential skills for employability and entrepreneurship. The Employability module focused on strategies to enhance career development and strengthen professional profiles. Participants engaged in creating personal enterprises, practicing their delivery during a live elevator pitch session, and refining their resumes and CVs in dedicated workshops.

The Innovation and Entrepreneurial Mindset sessions inspired participants to think creatively and develop forward-thinking business ideas. Through theoretical lessons and practical activities like the "Shark Tank" brainstorming challenge and entrepreneurial mindset simulations, participants explored how to transform ideas into concrete ventures. They analyzed real-world case studies of successful startups and discussed the diverse cultural attitudes towards innovation and entrepreneurship.
