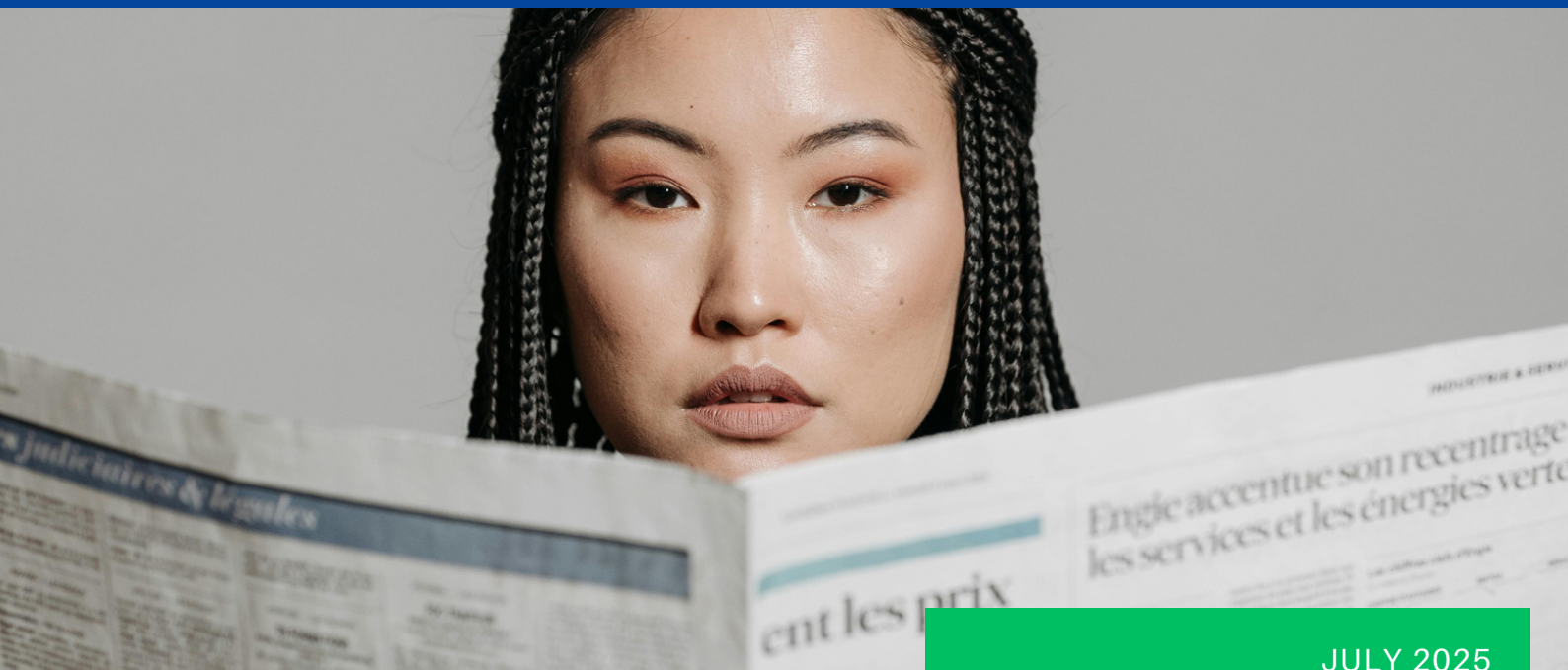


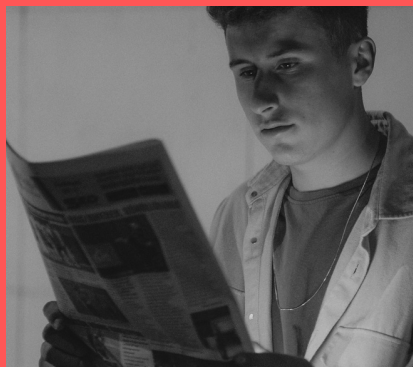

In the Media & Digital Skills Module, we began with an in-depth exploration of Media Literacy and Critical Thinking. Participants learned about the importance and role of media literacy in today's information landscape, developing skills to critically evaluate media content and avoid misinformation.
