In February, we were focused on developing leadership and management skills through combination of theoretical sessions and particular workshops to improve intercultural dialogue. Participants explored the characteristics of effective leadership and the differences between being a leader and a manager.

At the same time, the project introduced participants to the role of artificial intelligence and future leadership in education, through discussions and case studies on the use of ChatGPT.

Participants strengthen their digital skills as they were working with creative tools such as Kahoot, Quizizz, Edupuzzle, Padlet, Microsoft Office Tools, Canva and Google platforms.
