In April, the SWITCH project completed a series of dynamic activities to improve participants skills. We started with time management and adaptability activities, through tools like Eisenhower Matrix and Circadian Rhythm.

We wanted also to focus on interculturality, by analyzing social and political issues and participating on debates and intercultural dialogue.

Participants shared their experiences from their countries and we highlighted the importance of interculturality in today's global contexts. Strong emphasis was given in Entrepreneurship and Team management skills.



Our participants through role playing focused on conflict resolution, building strong foundations for creating successful and inclusive teams.

Finally, on the sessions we explored Global Citizenship and the principles of Responsible Leadership, challenging our participants to "rewrite" migration narratives through the lens of inclusion and empathy.
